TEACHERS REPORT – Term 1

This term (term 1) the children have been very busy settling in and feeling a sense of belonging. The staff have been encouraging all the children to feel safe and secure in their new environments as well as reassuring the families that they are doing the right thing on drop off. The staff have been aware of which families may need a follow up phone call once their child has settled into kinder.

One of the aims for all the children at Mildura West Kindergarten is to get to know the morning routine and to be able to complete this with little or no assistance. It has been great to see so many of our children achieving this over the last term. Another of our aims has been for the children to settle at an activity after they have completed their morning routine. In the beginning it was difficult for some children but as the term has progressed we have made a great deal of progress with children who are happy to say goodbye to their parents.


